Association	Individuals/Businesses/Owners
Promote Solar Energy powering-Investigate solar energy for pond pumps.	Install Solar Energy at buildings.
Promote car pooling by assigning preferred parking for car pool vans.	Car pool.
Plant more trees in line with Association's tree guidelines	Gift a tree.
Install duck feeders. With Spring approaching, could provide extra food for new born ducklings, therefore maximizing their chances of surviving.	adopt a duck feeder.
Harvest baby succulents and provide to businesses for desk plants. Among other benefits, they are great noise absorbents.	Help with the harvest project.
Put in elements that would attract birds and butterflies	adopt a hummingbird feeder
Look into ways to expand recycling program	Recycle, Recycle, Recycle
In the remote areas of BH (like by Warner bridge/55 freeway), cultivate wild growth areas so bees and butterflies can thrive.	adopt a wild growth area
Install more bike parking racks	Gift a bike rack.
Create butterfly gardens.	
Allow reserved parking spaces for environmentally friendly cars	
Investigate benefits of obtaining a Wildlife Habitat designation for Brookhollow.
